- **Personal Finance Class:** Learn budgeting, saving, investing, and biblical stewardship.
- **Mentorship & Leadership Labs:** Guide younger children through reading, crafts, or outdoor exploration.
- **Discipleship Workshops:** Lead devotionals, prayer groups, and Scripture-based discussions.
