

Track 3: The Potter

Sample Experiences:

- **“I Wonder” Projects:** Turn curiosity questions into research and creative projects. This track is designed to help students pursue and study the passions and interests God gave them. (e.g., *How do bees make honey? How did people build castles? How does music affect emotions?*) and turn them into research + creative projects.
- **Creative Showcase Days:** Share your passions in art, music, inventions, or stories with peers and parents.
- **Field Trips-** Gain hands-on experience through educational adventures.

Monthly Themes for Identity, Purpose & Calling

1. **Who Am I?** (Identity in Christ)
2. **Gifts & Talents Discovery**
 - Strengths inventories, try new skills (art, coding, gardening, music).
3. **Stories of Calling**
 - Study biblical figures (Moses, Esther, David) and modern role models.
4. **Dreaming with God**
 - Vision boards, journaling on Jeremiah 29:11, and goal setting.
5. **Faith & Creativity**
 - Explore how creativity reflects God as Creator (Genesis 1).
6. **Serving with Talents**
 - Use passions for service: art donations, music at outreach, and teaching skills to younger children.
