Track 3: The Potter

Sample Experiences:

- "I Wonder" Projects: Turn curiosity questions into research and creative projects. This track is designed to help students pursue and study the passions and interests God gave them. (e.g., How do bees make honey? How did people build castles? How does music affect emotions?) and turn them into research + creative projects.
- **Creative Showcase Days:** Share your passions in art, music, inventions, or stories with peers and parents.
- Field Trips- Gain hands-on experience through educational adventures.

5. Faith & Creativity

Explore how creativity reflects God as Creator (Genesis 1).

6. Serving with Talents

 Use passions for service: art donations, music at outreach, and teaching skills to younger children.
