Track 2: Feed My Sheep

Community Service · Leadership · Stewardship · Discipleship

Scripture: John 21:17, 1 Peter 4:10

This track centers on servant leadership, community outreach, and discipleship. Students practice empathy, teamwork, and humility as they learn that greatness is found in serving others.

Sample Experiences:

- Elder Wisdom Project: Interview nursing home residents and write biographies
 of their life stories., Connect residents' personal stories to broader historical
 events (e.g., WWII, 9/11, Civil Rights era, local history). Students compose
 narrative biographies or turn stories into memoir-style writings. Discuss honoring
 elders (Exodus 20:12, Proverbs 16:31). Write reflections on wisdom passed
 down.
- Local Ministry & Outreach: Volunteer in resource centers, gaining civic and social skills. Track donations, supplies, or meal counts, and create charts to show their impact. Study passages on service (Matthew 25:35-40) and journal personal applications.
- Donating what we grow in our gardens to food pantries. Predication of cost versus yield. Nutrients that the community needs, economics.
- Planning community presentations to teach others about growing their own food, and public speaking.
- Planting our own flowers and creating bouquets for others. -Grow flowers
 and arrange them into gifts for hospitals, churches, or neighbors. Learn about
 plant biology, pollination, and floral design. Practice symmetry and proportion in
 bouquet arrangements. Connect to beauty in creation and service through small
 acts of kindness (Song of Solomon 2:12, Philippians 2:4). Write short
 encouragement notes or scripture-based cards to accompany bouquets.
